



Reforestation & Beautification Committee (RBC)

Application and Release Form:

Any owner who wants to plant a tree of any kind in his or her property, is required by the HOA, to fill out the enclosed form together with a copy or drawing of the projected place of planting.

No application will be approved if such planting is near the building structure or interferes with your immediate neighbors' property line. (The RBC will recommend the best favorable place for planting of the tree using the drawings submitted.)

The type or variety of the tree must be specified when filling out this form. Not all kind or types of trees will be considered.

Upon completion and approval of this request, the resident, assumes full responsibility of any damages to his or her neighbors' property, as a result of the tree natural growth of roots, branches and foliage, while the tree is planted on his or her property.

Access to maintenance personnel and equipment should be considered when picking up a planting spot.

Check here if tree is meant to be planted on common grounds.
